WEEKLY STEWARDSHIP RECOMMENDATION:

Buy Fresh, Local, Organic

Food travels an average of 1,200 miles before
it reaches your plate, so buying locally grown
can save energy and prevent air pollution. Also,
fresh foods require significantly less energy than
frozen foods (but watch out for spoilage which
contributes to food waste!). Organics benefit
the environment by not relying on synthetic
pesticides or fertilizers which can contaminate
soil and water. Other benefits of using fresh, local
and organic sources can be healthier foods with
better taste. Farmers markets and Community
Supported Agriculture (CSAs) are both great ways
to support a local food system.
