Reading for August 30, 2026

Matthew 16: 21-27

Adults:

How have you “taken up” the crosses that have been placed in your life (accepted, ignored, with resistance, etc.)? What have you learned from these experiences?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God’s word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God’s word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God’s presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God’s presence and be still, surrounded by God’s love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God’s nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

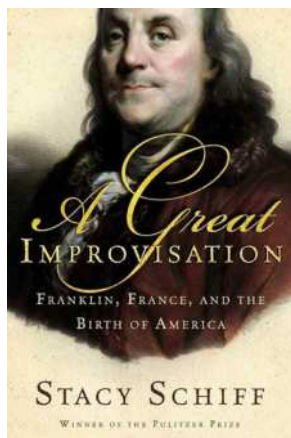

The Catholic Community of Christ Our Light Children's Liturgy of the Word



CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW) will resume on Sunday, September 27 at the 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Masses.

The purpose of this special Liturgy is twofold:

- To provide a quality liturgical experience
- To facilitate the proclamation and breaking open of Scripture with the children

What is Children's Liturgy of the Word?

- CLOW is a part of the Mass
- The Church encourages a separate liturgy to allow the children to participate and understand
- Appropriate for children between the ages of 5 and 12
- All are welcome - No registration is necessary
- We meet in the church and the children remain with the assembly and their parents for the opening of Mass
- The children are dismissed by the celebrant after the Opening Prayer.

Gather the Children

- The children form two groups: second grade and younger; third grade and older
- They are led to rooms in the Ministry Center of the church
- A candle is lit to remind the children of the presence of the Lord; they are reminded that they are still at Mass.
- A Reading, Responsorial Psalm, and Gospel are read.
- An interactive sharing follows: the children discuss what they heard; what the readings mean to them; practical ways they can incorporate what they heard into their everyday lives.
- The children return to the assembly after the Offertory Procession



VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED

- Adults and teens are needed to proclaim and share the Word of God
- Requirements: enthusiasm and the willingness to share your faith with the children of Christ Our Light Parish
- Scheduling is approximately once a month
- All materials are provided and emailed and mailed home the week before you are scheduled
- Facilitators do not have to come up with ideas - just present them and, most of all, let the children LEAD you.
- Feel free to come back with the children during a CLOW session to observe
- Facilitators have commented that they learn so much from the children
- As one child said, "CLOW helps me understand; I don't understand all those big words."

The World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation

Pope Leo XIV is releasing the 2026 World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, which is traditionally celebrated each year on September 1st. This year's prayer highlights the connection between armed conflict and environmental degradation. Such degradation constitutes a serious violation of our duty to care for creation. It also poses a long-term threat to the lives of hundreds of millions of people. The now widespread awareness of the impact of war on natural resources has not led to the creation of adequate institutions or to responsible decisions aimed at preventing conflicts and resolving disputes peacefully. The title — a passage in which Isaiah prophesies the transformation of weapons into agricultural tools — is an explicit invitation to prioritize development and sustainability over violence and destruction.

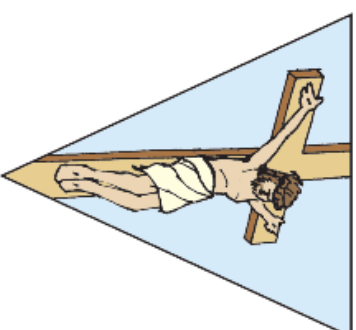
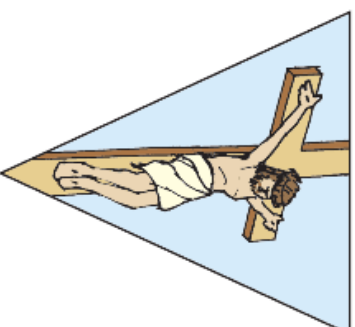
