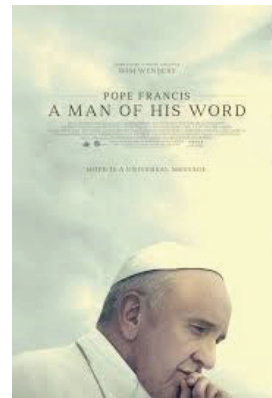

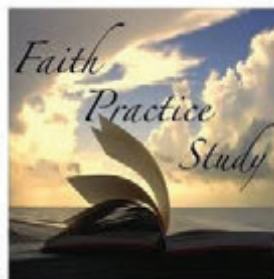
Pope Francis: A Man of His Word

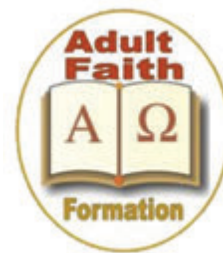

Sandwich Making Ministry

100,000 Sandwiches A Million Smiles

In November of 2012, a new ministry began at Christ Our Light: sandwich making. In the early days, the core committee would pick up meat donations from Dietz and Watson and slice the donated meat in the then-vacant Queen of Heaven convent. It was quite an operation!

Since then, parishioners, parish groups, religious education classes, youth ministry and classes and groups from RCS have embraced this ministry of feeding our brothers and sisters in need. The sandwiches have been donated to Cathedral Kitchen, Joseph's House, the Cherry Hill Food pantry, New Visions (when it was open) and even the Neighborhood Center in Camden.

This weekend we mark our 100,000 sandwiches: 100,000 moments of generosity and good will; 100,000 opportunities to meet and get to know other people in the parish over two slices of bread, a slice of American cheese and turkey breast or beef bologna. While we knew the sandwiches might provide some temporary relief from hunger, what we did not anticipate is how much we would benefit from this activity which has and continues to build community among us and raise awareness about those who suffer from hunger and food insecurity.

A special thanks goes to the core committee which has been at this from the very beginning: Kathy and Steve Zippilli, Tom and Ginny deWolf, Mary Horvath, Chris Kaelin, Matt Kilroy, Jan and Pete Cote, Janet Giordano and Pat Slater. We also thank our "silent partner" on the core committee, who has supported sandwich making with an anonymous monetary donation for many of these years.

The core committee helps shop for the supplies, staff the set-up, clean up and delivery for our monthly sandwich making event (typically the last Sunday of the month). They also help with parish groups who want to sponsor their own sandwich making. There is no ongoing commitment to help every month. The core committee members just help as they are able.

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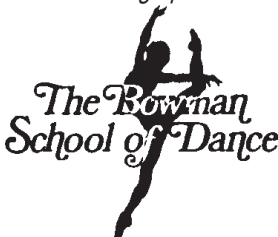
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
