- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

When have you let someone down who trusted you? How did you feel? What did you do about it?

Children:

How can you spend time with each member of your family this week to show your love for them?

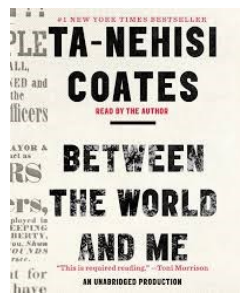

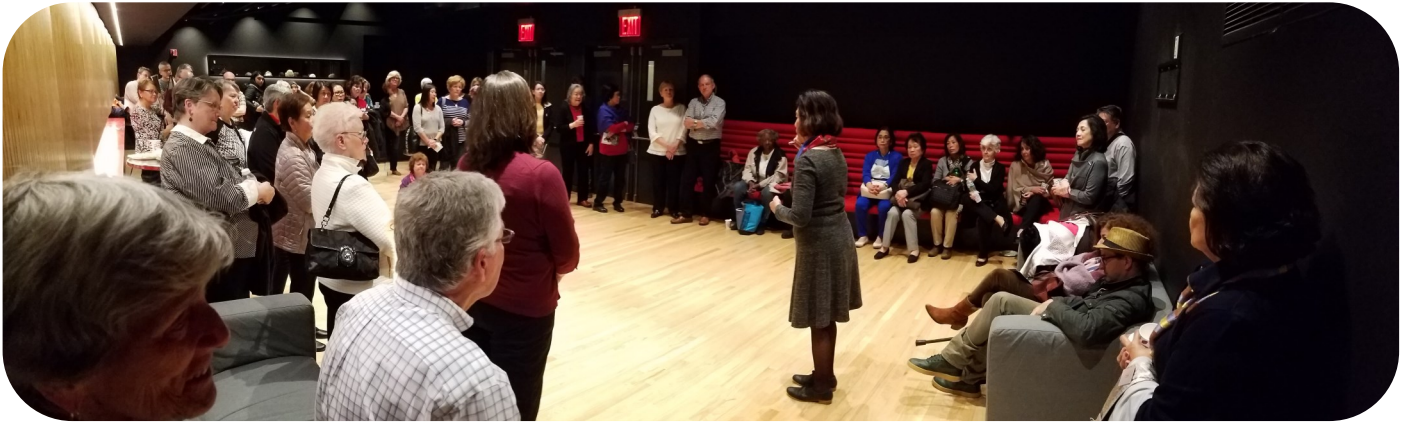

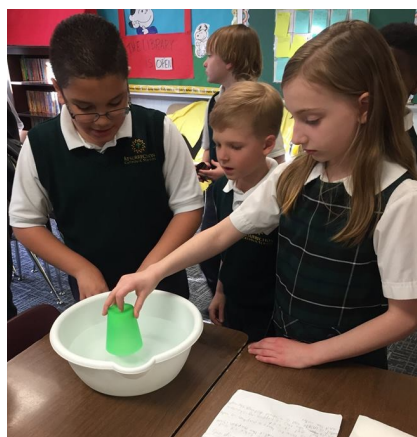
