- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

The Elementary Faith Formation office is accepting registrations for students grade Pre-K through 8 for the catechetical year beginning September 2019. Families whose children currently attend classes at COL have received re-registration materials, with completed forms and fees due by May 30, 2019. Families new to Elementary Faith Formation (Pre-K – 6th) or Youth Faith Formation (7th & 8th) can access registration forms from the parish website, or families can register and pay online. Online registration includes a \$3.00 processing fee. See the parish website homepage for more information. NOTE: Children must attend Elementary Faith Formation class for one year prior to preparing to celebrate 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist. Families are encouraged to begin their child's faith formation in first grade.

Cherry Hill Public School 5th grade students have opportunities to participate in All Cherry Hill Chorus and other activities whose practice times are Monday afternoons. Our parish involvement with Cathedral Kitchen dates back almost to its beginning in 1976. We supported the Kitchen by making casseroles

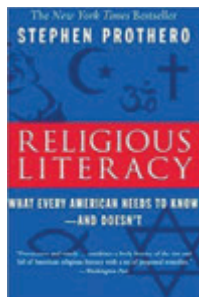

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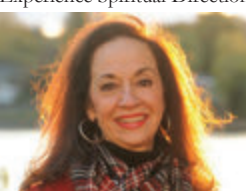
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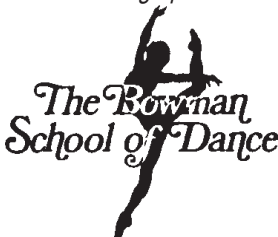
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
