Reading for June 2, 2019

John 17: 20-26

Adults:

Jesus invites us to be one with God. Name a moment when you were one with God this past week.

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

Jesus prayed for his disciples, that others might believe in him through their words. How are you spreading your belief in Jesus through your words and actions? Do others know who Jesus is by knowing you?

Children:

Jesus tells us He is always with us. Name a time this past week when you knew that God was with you in a special way.

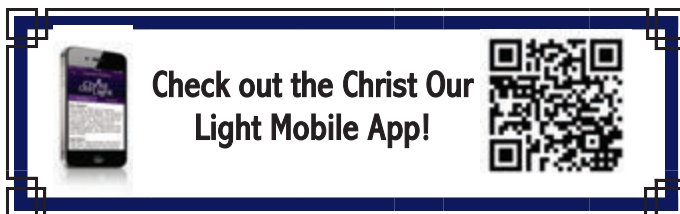

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION FOR 2019 – 2020 (April 28 – June 10)

The Elementary Faith Formation office is accepting registrations for students grade Pre-K through 8 for the catechetical year beginning September 2019. Families whose children currently attend classes at COL have received re-registration materials, with completed forms and fees due by May 30, 2019. Families new to Elementary Faith Formation (Pre-K – 6th) or Youth Faith Formation (7th & 8th) can access registration forms from the parish website, or families can register and pay online. Online registration includes a \$3.00 processing fee. See the parish website homepage for more information. 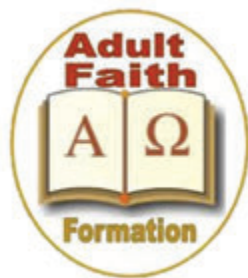

Cherry Hill Food Pantry



WE HAVE LOST OUR LEASE !

At the Cherry Hill Food Pantry our mission is to follow Jesus' exhortation from Luke 3:10-11, "And the crowds asked him, What then shall we do?" And He answered them, "Whoever has two tunics is to share with him who has none, and whoever has food is to do likewise."

We have a total of 677 households currently registered as clients and continue to accept new registrants weekly. Our client base includes 555 children under the age of eighteen, 1,153 adults between the ages of 18 and 64, and 338 senior citizens. Our clients include at-risk children, adults with various hardships, seniors and individuals with disabilities. The groceries we distribute each week include meat, eggs and dairy plus fresh fruits and vegetables that are otherwise unaffordable or unavailable to our clients. In 2018 we distributed over 520,000 pounds of food to our clients.

We have a lease agreement with KIMCO for our space at the Brace Road Shopping Center that expires June 30, 2019. KIMCO does not charge us rent. We only pay expenses.

We have been notified that there is a plan to revitalize the center and all but 4 of the current tenants have been asked to leave, including the Cherry Hill Food Pantry. KIMCO does not have any other vacant space in their inventory that is suitable for our needs. We will therefore have to find a new space on our own and we will need to raise the capital necessary to pay a market rental rate. If you know of any space available, preferably in the Cherry Hill area, that is between 6,000 and 8,000 square feet, please contact Janet Giordano at cherryhillnjfoodpantry@gmail.com or (856) 912-2353.

We will also now need to form partnerships with corporate and private benefactors in order to remain in existence and continue our mission to feed those in need. Many of our clients tell us that they don't know what they would do if we had to close. If you can help provide financial support, please contact Janet and make a pledge or contribution.

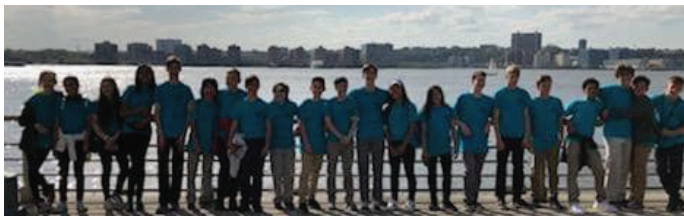

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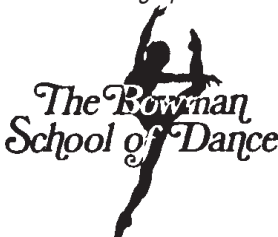
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
