Reading for January 12, 2019

Matthew 3: 13 – 17

Adults: We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens: How do you live your baptismal promises as a way of life?

Children: Ask someone when you were baptized and what happened to you when you were baptized. Since your baptism shows you are a child of God and loved by God, how do you show that you love God?

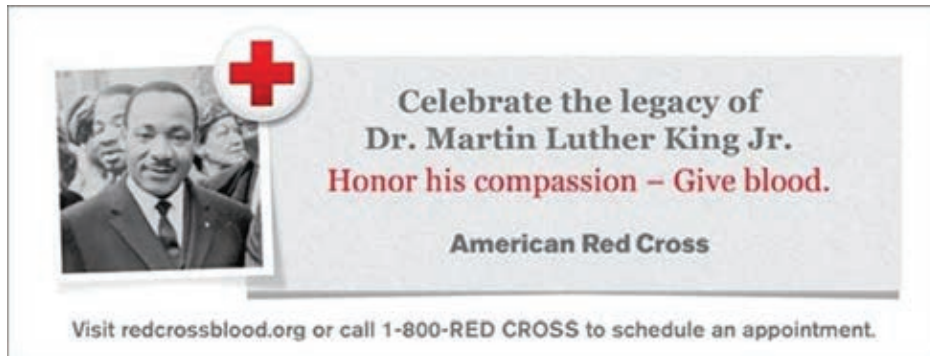

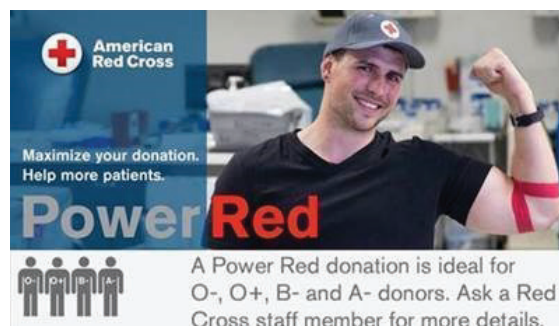
