Reading for May 31, 2020

John 20:19-23

Adults:

What does it mean to be church? In what ways are you sent into the world to share the peace of Christ?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

How will you share the peace of Jesus with those you see this week? How can you spread the Good News of Jesus to others this week?

Children:

How does Jesus want you to treat your family and friends at all times?

2020 One Book, One Christ Our Light



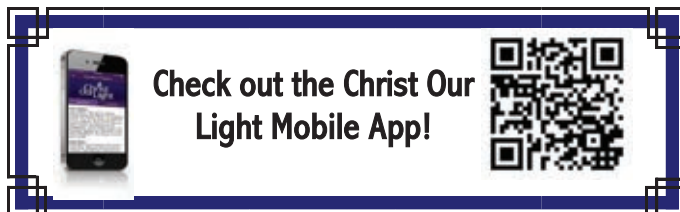

Although we do not know how long COVID-19 will continue to alter our lives, some things must go forward. One of those is registration for Faith Formation classes 2020-2021. However, because COL offices are closed we will not be mailing home information and registration forms. All registrations must be completed electronically. The good news is that for the third year in a row COL has not increased fees. Fees are set:

\$175.00 1st student
\$ 45.00 each additional student
\$ 45.00 per child for Pre-k/K

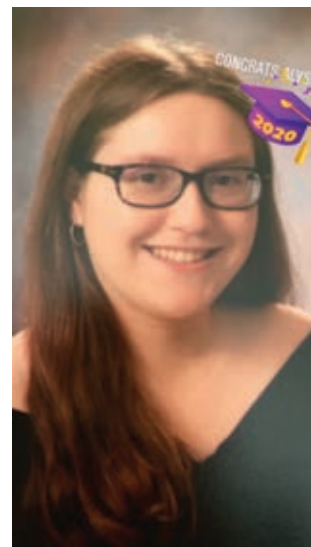

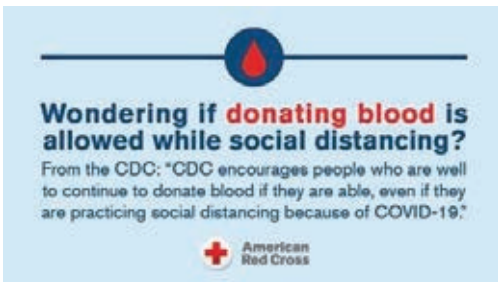

Our next delivery of casseroles to Joseph's House of Camden will be Monday morning, June 15, 2020. Thank you so much for your generous donations in May. We were able to deliver 39 casseroles, coffee, sugar, creamer, snacks, cookies, cleaning products, toiletries, socks and other clothing.

Because there are no scheduled liturgies for the near future, all casseroles and other donations for Joseph's House should be dropped off in the Servers Room in the Ministry Center. The doors will be unlocked. Casseroles can be put in the freezer and other items on the cart. **If you can, please use pans and lids provided** for the casseroles in the lower left cabinet on the church wall behind the Welcome Desk. Mark with date prepared and main ingredients. **Whatever you use, please make sure lids are secure and tight to keep food safe and sanitary.**

In addition to casseroles, the following items are most needed at this time.

- Hand soap
- Hand Sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol (travel size or larger)
- Clorox Wipes
- Disinfectant Spray
- Bottled Water
- Sandwiches (cheese and turkey or beef bologna-please use gloves and disinfect surfaces to make these)
- Individually packaged snacks such as cheese and crackers, granola bars, trail mix, etc.
- Coffee
- Coffee Creamer – powdered
- Sugar

In these unprecedented times where demand for services has expanded and availability of supplies shrunk, monetary donations are also gratefully accepted and will support JH in the long term. You can donate by visiting the Joseph House website at www.jhoc.org.
