Adults:

- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

In re The Diocese of Camden, New Jersey
Case No. 20-21257 (JNP)

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on October 1, 2020, The Diocese of Camden, New Jersey, (the "Diocese") filed for protection under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code.

The Bankruptcy Court has established June 30, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the "**Bar Date**").

If you have a claim against the Diocese including, without limitation, a claim related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date with Prime Clerk, the appointed Claims Agent.

We have learned that Catholics in the care of a certain home hospice agency have been connected with a minister who is a

former priest of the Camden Diocese, excommunicated by the Holy See for joining the Old Catholic Church. Ambiguously represents himself as a legitimate priest. While interacting with hospice chaplains of other religious is not a problem, when it comes to the administration of the Sacraments, you deserve to see a Catholic priest! If you are ever unsure, ask the minister if he is a Catholic priest. Ambiguously-named groups like the Old Catholic Church, the Polish National Catholic Church, and others, are not the same thing as the Catholic Church. Your parish priests are here to make sure you receive the spiritual care you need. Call the parish office when you are in need, and please don't wait until the last minute.

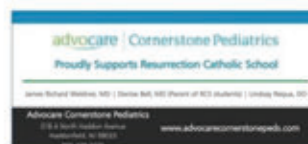
