John 10: 11-18

### Adults:

What qualities of God does the image of the Good Shepherd suggest? How do you experience God in this way? We offer this form of contemplative sharing for pondering Scripture while considering the question, and for the faith sharing which follows.

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

How do you feel about Jesus' being your shepherd? What does it mean to you that he lays down his life for you?

### Children:

Jesus tells us he is the Good Shepherd. How do you experience God guiding and protecting you?

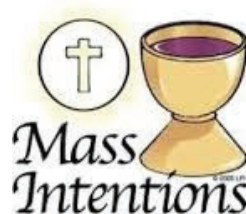

**One of the biggest things I learned from this year is probably patience.**

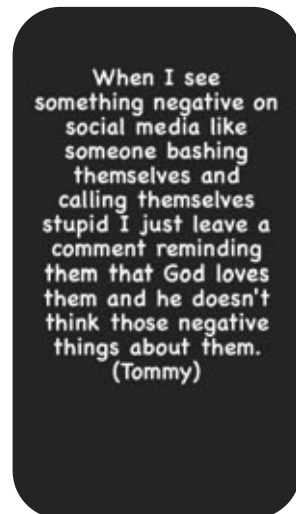
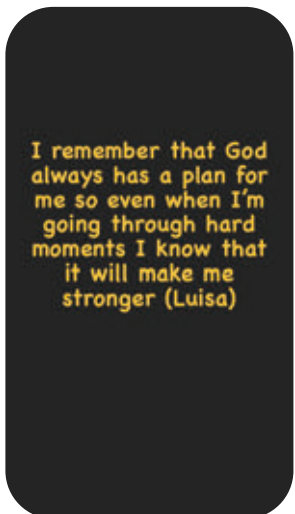
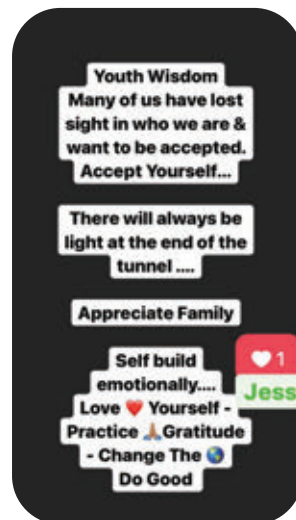
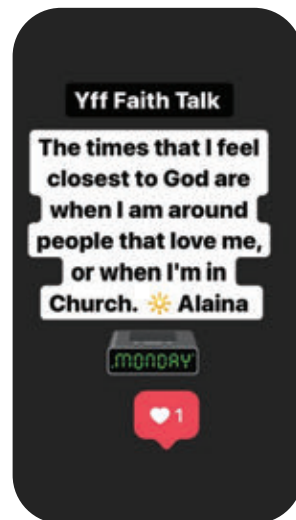
