FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

First, we give praise to God that the pandemic in our state and country is dwindling down. We are starting to see the beginnings of what life will be after enduring all that COVID-19 thrust upon us. Please continue to pray for those countries in our world that are still struggling and that we will provide them with the assistance that they need.

Secondly, with the Governor loosening restrictions and guidance received from our own chancery, you will begin to notice some changes in our church over the next few weeks. Beginning Friday, May 28th, those participating in Mass who are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 are no longer required to wear face masks. Those who are not fully vaccinated are encouraged to wear face masks in accordance with CDC and diocesan guidelines. I encourage all our parishioners to consult with their doctors about getting vaccinated. Priests, Deacons, and EM's will continue to sanitize their hands prior to the distribution of Communion.

Finally, as of June 5th/6th, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, the Bishops of New Jersey are reinstating the obligation to attend Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. That weekend, most of the pews will be available for seating, as the six foot physical distancing requirement is no longer required and the indoor capacity limit has been lifted. Pews in two sections of church (nearest Kings Highway) will remain roped off for those who wish to maintain a physical distance from non-family members. Also beginning the weekend of June 5th/6th, we will eliminate the distribution of Communion between noon and 12:30pm on Sundays after the 11 AM. If your health prevents you from attending mass in person, please contact the parish office to arrange for the Eucharist brought to your home by a visiting EM.

More detailed information in accordance with diocesan guidelines will follow regarding meeting spaces and ministry programs that meet at the Church, Parish Center or School. Let us continue to pray with and for our entire parish family.

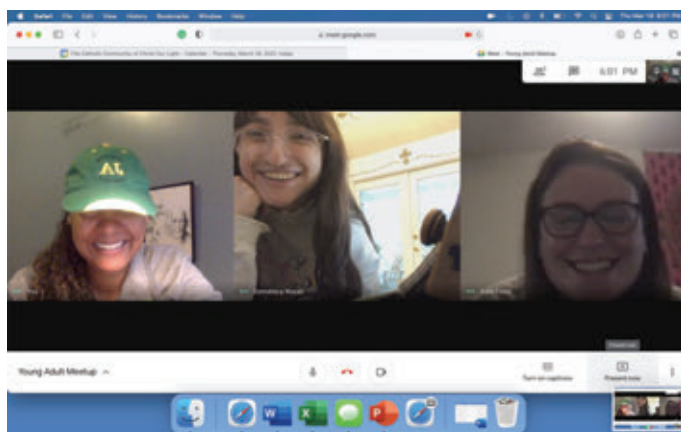

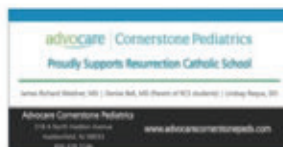

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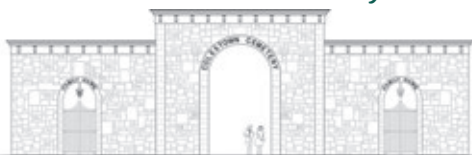
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
