Reading for June 20, 2021

Mark 4:35-41

Adults:

Recall a situation when you were searching for faith and trust - did you take it to a friend, a family member, to God in prayer?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Teens:

Whom do you go to when you need a different perspective on a concern or worry that you have?

Children:

What concerns can you share with Jesus so that he can calm you worries?

The Elementary Faith Formation office is accepting registrations for students grade Pre-K through 8 for the catechetical year beginning September 2021. Families whose children currently attend weekly classes at COL have received re-registration materials.. NOTE: 1ST RECONCILIATION & 1ST EUCHARIST

Children are eligible to prepare for and celebrate the sacraments of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist only if they have successfully completed a full year of EFF. With that in mind parents / guardians are encouraged to begin a child's Elementary Faith Formation upon entering 1st grade.

In re The Diocese of Camden, New Jersey
Case No. 20-21257 (JNP)

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT on October 1, 2020, The Diocese of Camden, New Jersey, (the "Diocese") filed for protection under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code.

The Bankruptcy Court has established **June 30, 2021 at 11:59 p.m.** (prevailing Eastern time) as the deadline to file proofs of claim against the Diocese (the "**Bar Date**").

If you have a claim against the Diocese including, without limitation, a claim related to sexual abuse committed by any person connected with the Diocese, you must file a claim on or before the Bar Date with Prime Clerk, the appointed Claims Agent.

Healing from a Lost Year

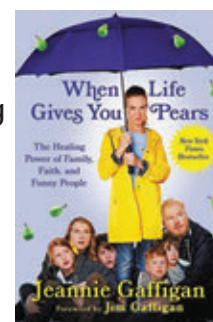

ALL ARE WELCOME. You have heard it over and over, and the phrase is emblazoned on the sign on the front lawn of our church. This is not just a nice saying, but a commitment that we as a faith community have made, and have recommitted to in our Pastoral Strategic Plan Vision 2024. Our community thrives on diversity and life-giving relationships, and creating a safe, open, and welcoming space for worship and service is a priority of the parish. We are happy to report that Christ Our Light is the first New Jersey Catholic parish to express public support of the statement *God Is On Your Side: A Statement From Catholic Bishops On Protecting LGBT Youth*. We join Cardinal Joseph A. Tobin, the metropolitan of the five Roman Catholic dioceses in the state of New Jersey, in support of this statement.

From the statement:

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that LGBT people are to be treated with "respect, compassion and sensitivity." ... The Catholic Church values the God-given dignity of all human life and we take this opportunity to say to our LGBT friends, especially young people, that we stand with you and oppose any form of violence, bullying or harassment directed at you.

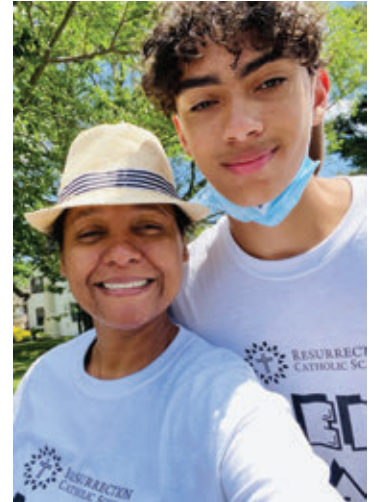

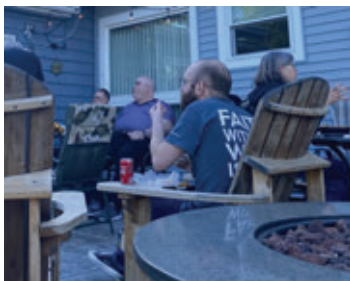
