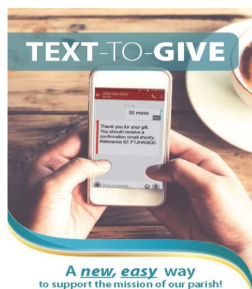

Matthew 14: 12-23

Adults:

Like the Apostles, we must leave some things behind when Jesus calls. What have you given up to follow Jesus and how has he rewarded you?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

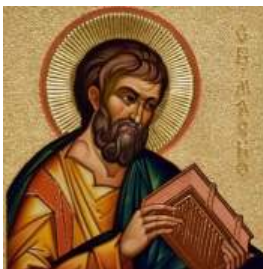

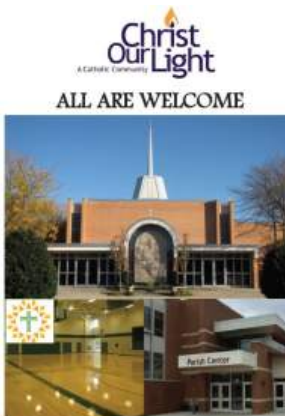

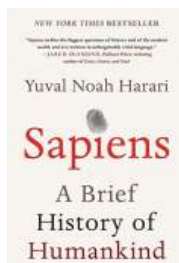

Here is a look at some of the other liturgical ministries that John spoke to the Pastoral Council about at our November meeting.

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EM's) – EM's serve the community by assisting in the distribution of communion at all parish liturgies. EM's are trained through the diocesan Office of Worship School of Liturgy programs. Once that training is complete, individuals are prepared to serve at Christ Our Light by parish staff or other experienced EM's. schedules are created based on individual availability and the needs of the parish. There are currently 58 EM's, with 5 new prospective ministers. Mass Assistants – formerly known as the Usher ministry, this new ministry serves the parish community in the celebration of the liturgy. As ministers of hospitality, Mass Assistants greet people and assist in seating as needed. Their responsibilities include coordinating the offering of gifts, assisting anyone with special needs, ensuring the church is ready for the next Mass, and other duties as necessary for special occasions. The goal is to have 3-6 Mass Assistants at every Mass. There are 26 active Mass Assistants. Modern Catholic social teaching has been articulated through a tradition of papal, conciliar, and episcopal documents. In seven reflections, the key themes at the heart of our Catholic social tradition are highlighted.

Theme 3 of 7 Rights and Responsibilities

The Catholic tradition teaches that human dignity can be protected and a healthy community can be achieved only if human rights are protected and responsibilities are met. Therefore, every person has a fundamental right to life and a right to those things required for human decency. Corresponding to these rights are duties and responsibilities – to one another, to our families, and to the larger society.
