COME and SEE



Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." (John 20:19-31)

At the Last Supper, Jesus speaks to His disciples about His impending death and assured them that when they see Him again, their hearts will rejoice with joy no one can take from them. (John 16:22) The gospel narrative today helps to move the disciples from fear to joy, seclusion to mission, disbelief to faith, mere existence to new life. Jesus breathes on them, giving them the Holy Spirit. Jesus gives them peace and the power to heal and forgive sins. He sends them to continue the mission for which the Father sent Him.

Today, the church celebrates Divine Mercy Sunday, the Second Sunday of the Easter Season. It was named by Pope John Paul II at the canonization of St. Maria Faustina on April 30, 2000 and then officially decreed by the Vatican. Divine Mercy Sunday can be seen as the convergence of all the mysteries and graces of the Holy Week and Easter Week. The feast focuses on the light of the Risen Christ into a radiant beam of merciful love and grace for the whole world. The message of Divine Mercy is simple. It is that God loves us – all of us. And, He wants us to recognize that His mercy is greater than our sins, so that we will call upon Him with trust, receive His mercy, and let it flow through us to others. Thus, all will come to share His joy.

At Baptism, we are called to continue the mission for which the Father had sent Jesus. Let us share the Good News that the Risen Christ has saved us by the way we live. As we meditate in gratitude for God's mercy shown to us, we should look honestly at the mercy we show others. Our God is a God of mercy. May we always be a church of mercy. Come and See.

Adults:

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Youth:

Jesus' words of greeting were "Peace be with you," followed by the invitation to forgive sins. How does forgiveness bring peace to you? How does it change the world?

Children:

How can you believe in Jesus whom you have never seen?

Eucharistic Revival



As we continue our year of parish-level Eucharistic Revival, let us take some time on this Divine Mercy Sunday to meditate on an excerpt from *Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska - Divine Mercy in My Soul*:

"The mercy of God, hidden in the Blessed Sacrament, the voice of the Lord who speaks to us from the throne of mercy: Come to Me, all of you.

Behold, for you I have established a throne of mercy on earth — the tabernacle — and from this throne I desire to enter into your heart. I am not surrounded by a retinue of guards. You can come to me at any moment, at any time; I want to speak to you and I desire to grant you grace.

...You left us Yourself in the Sacrament of the Altar, and You opened wide Your mercy to us. There is no misery that could exhaust You; You have called us all to this fountain of love, to this spring of God's compassion. Here is the tabernacle of Your mercy, here is the remedy for all our ills. To You, O living spring of mercy, all souls are drawn; some like deer, thirsting for Your love, others to wash the wound of their sins and still others, exhausted by life, to draw strength.

O Jesus, concealed in the Blessed Sacrament of the Altar, my only love and mercy, I commend to You all the needs of my body and soul. You can help me, because You are Mercy itself. In You lies all my hope.

Be adored, O God, in the work of Your mercy, be blessed by all faithful hearts on whom Your gaze rests, in whom dwells Your immortal life. In Your inconceivable love, You allowed Your most holy side to be opened, and streams of Blood and Water gushed forth from Your Heart. Here is the living fountain of Your mercy, here souls receive consolation and refreshment. In the Blessed Sacrament, You left us Your mercy; Your love deigned to arrange it so, that, going through life, suffering and toil, I might never doubt of Your goodness and mercy. Amen."

Brain Injury Awareness Month

Over 5 million Americans are estimated to be living with the effects of a traumatic brain injury (TBI).

TBIs are more common in males and most common in teenagers and

young adults, aged 15-24 years. Young children (under the age of five) and the elderly (over the age of 75) are also at an increased risk. The most common cause (accounting for 50%) of TBIs are related to motor vehicle crashes. Other common causes include falls (the number one cause in older adults) and sports related injuries. TBIs can range from concussions to more serious and life-threatening injuries.

Prevention is key! Helpful tips to avoid common causes of brain injury include:

- Always use your seat belt and/or the proper restraint for children when in a motor vehicle
- Use the appropriate helmet and protective gear when engaging in sports or athletic activities
- Remove slip and trip hazards in homes such as unsecured rugs
- Ensure adequate lighting (ex. nightlights) in the dark and/or on stairs, etc.

Whenever you have an injury to your head — a visit to healthcare provider is ALWAYS in order.

Christ is Risen! He is Alive!

A festival of the light of Christ is a way of celebrating the resurrection which, for each person, already begins invisibly here on earth. Upon entering the church, which should be dimly lit, everyone receives a small candle. While a song of resurrection is sung, each person's candle is lit, until the whole church is full of light. This is a sign of the light of Christ, which also symbolizes our identity as Christians as children of the light. Then one of the Gospel accounts of the resurrection can be read, followed by more joyful meditative singing.

Taizé Community is a monastic order in Taizé, in Burgundy, France. Prayer together, three times a day, is at the heart of life in Taizé. This is a quite simple style of prayer which includes a few songs, a psalm, a Bible reading, a time of silence, and then intercessions. Short songs (chants), sung again and again, give it a meditative character. The words and phrases used in these chants are taken from the Holy Bible or writings of saints. Meditative singing thus becomes a way of listening to God. It allows everyone to take part in a time of prayer together and to remain together in attentive waiting on God.
