Reading for May 12, 2024
Mark 16:15-20

Adults:

Jesus asks us to go into the whole world to preach salvation in His name. Granted, we are not missionaries who go off into foreign lands, nevertheless how have we brought the saving message of the Gospel to others?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Jesus said to his disciples: "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature." (Mark 16:15-20)

Today is the feast of the Ascension, the day when Jesus left the world to unite with his Father. Yet as he was leaving, he gave this great mission to his apostles, to Go into the world and proclaim the Good News to the whole creation. He addressed these solemn words to a small group of disciples who had never been particularly impressive witnesses of his teachings. Yet he entrusted them and promised them the help they needed to carry out this impossible mission. But the most impressive thing of all is that they did carry out this mission, so the Gospel is now spread throughout the entire world.

Pope Francis is calling us today to obey the Lord's command given 2,000 years ago. We are to figure out how to work together in sharing the Good News. 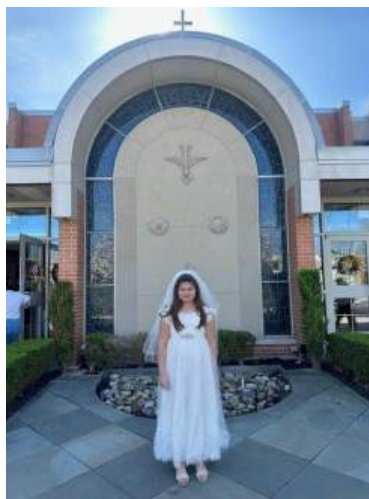

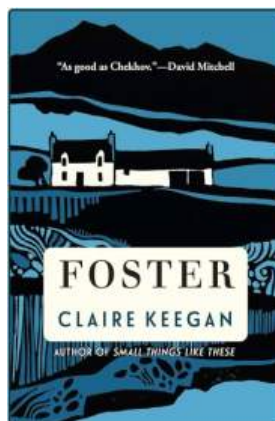
Hospitality - Coffee & Donuts

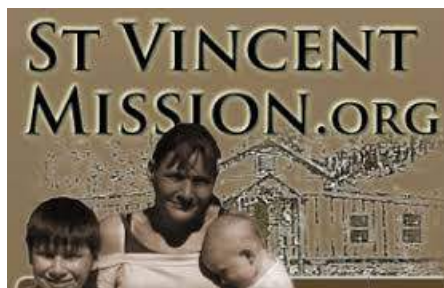

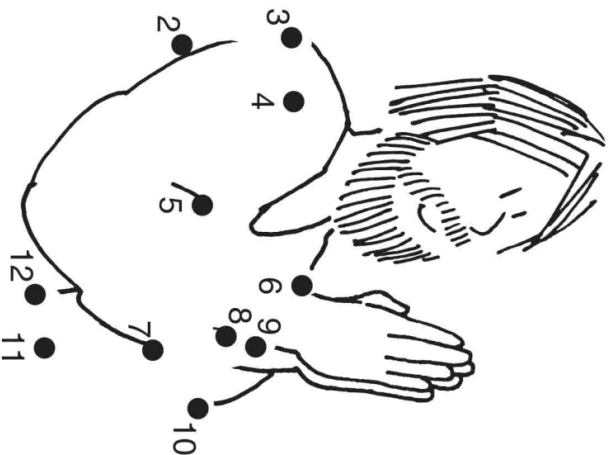

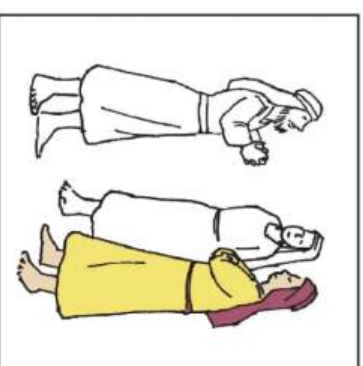
