Reading for May 11, 2025

John 13:31-33A, 34-35

Adults:

Who is your role model for being a person who follows this command of Jesus?

We offer this form of *Lectio Divina* (sacred reading) for pondering Scripture and for faith sharing with family members and other people.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Children:

How can you show your love for other people?

Chair Yoga

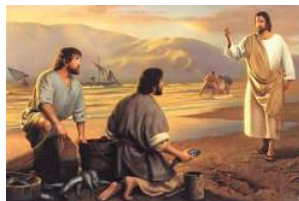


This practice links the movement of the breath with gentler yoga postures. De-stress while you stretch, strengthen, and breathe from the comfort of your chair.

Come and See



"The one who sits on the throne will shelter them. They will not hunger or thirst anymore, nor will the sun or any heat strike them. For the Lamb who is in the center of the throne will shepherd them and lead them to springs of life-giving water, and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes." Revelation 7:15-17

These Words as attributed to Saint John the Beloved, whom Jesus referred to as one of the sons of thunder. The words bring comfort, affirmation, and hope. Is not the Resurrection (as well the Easter Season) a reminder of the hope we hear in the Scripture above - which was our second reading for the 4th Sunday of Easter?

The words above - we try to strive for here on earth, to make this world a better place. There is no doubt that we should put our good works and efforts into such virtuous endeavors. However, we must always remember the end journey - our ultimate destination, Heaven.

It is affirming to know that such promises were given to us - it helps us to know that we are loved, and it leaves a goal for us to hope in, to be with Jesus forever in eternal glory.

John the Beloved saw all of the tribulations of his own day and that which would happen later, before Jesus' return and yet his focus remains on the love God has for us and what he has prepared for us.

We are not only to believe these words for ourselves, but share them with others, for man cannot live on bread alone, but by every word that comes from God. Making the world a better place is a goal but not the foundational one, lest we exchange heaven for earth, and grace for works, or the temporal for the eternal. Remember, this life is seen and transitory but the next is unseen and everlasting. Amen.

"Santacruzán", Spanish for "Holy Cross", honors the finding of the True Cross of Jesus by St. Helena. Early in the 4th century, St. Helena, mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine, went to Jerusalem in search of the True Cross. During the excavation, workers found 3 crosses. Legend has it that the one on which Jesus died was identified when its touch healed a dying person. Santacruzán is also celebrated in the month of May to honor the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Santacruzán is a grand procession that commemorates Queen Helena's journey. It features a parade of elegantly dressed participants representing various biblical and historical figures, each symbolizing virtues such as faith, hope and charity.

The celebration will begin with the Holy Rosary at 12:30 PM and the Holy Mass at 1:00 PM. A procession will follow and then fellowship at the Parish Center gym.
