



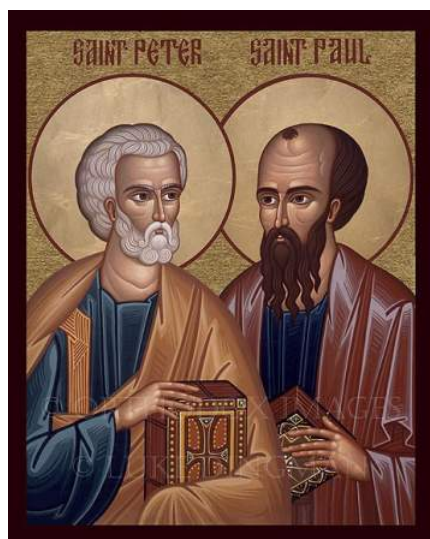

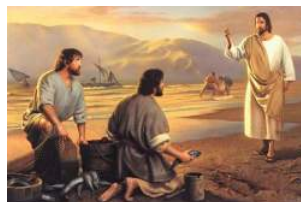

Come and See



At this Sunday's Masses, we are celebrating the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul who are foundational pillars of our Church. Peter is the rock on whom Jesus founded the

Church. Paul is the Apostle to the Gentiles and defender of our faith.

Let's look at a couple of the Saints' similarities and differences. Jesus similarly invited Peter and Paul to "Come and See" but in different ways. Jesus approached Simon Peter and his brother, Andrew, along the Sea of Galilee declaring 'Follow Me. I will make you fishers of men'. The brothers left their fishing nets and began following Jesus.

Paul's conversion to Christianity was much different. Paul, then known as Saul, was a Pharisee who persecuted the early followers of Jesus. On the road to Damascus, Saul experienced a piercing light that left him blind for three days. Simultaneously, Saul heard a voice asking him why he was persecuting Jesus. Saul recognized that Jesus was talking to him and his conversion began.

Legend has it that both Peter and Paul were executed for their Christian belief on the same day in different years (64 AD and 67 AD, respectively) by Emperor Nero and were buried in Rome. Paul was crucified upside down while Peter was beheaded. Both Saints knew that by following Jesus they had lived the good life and would be rewarded with eternal life in heaven.

In the year 395, St. Augustine said "Both apostles share the same feast day, for these two were one; and even though they suffered on different days, they were as one. Peter went first, and Paul followed. And so we celebrate this day made holy for us by the apostle's blood. Let us embrace what they believed, their life, their labors, their sufferings, their preaching, and their confession of faith."

In celebrating today's feast day, let us examine how Jesus beckons us to "Come and See" the goodness of the Lord so we too can be rewarded with eternal life.

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

All About Electrolytes

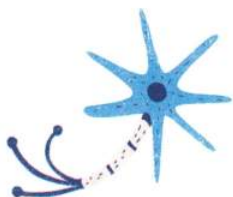
What is an Electrolyte?

Electrolytes are charged ions that conduct electrical impulses in the body. They play a crucial role in maintaining various physiological functions, including nerve and muscle function, fluid balance, and pH regulation.

Types of Electrolytes

- **Sodium (Na⁺):** Regulates fluid balance, nerve transmission, and muscle contraction.
- **Potassium (K⁺):** Important for heart and muscle contractions, nerve signals, and maintaining fluid balance.
- **Calcium (Ca²⁺):** Essential for bone health, muscle contractions, blood clotting, and nerve function.
- **Magnesium (Mg²⁺):** Involved in muscle and nerve function, energy production, and bone health.
- **Chloride (Cl⁻):** Helps maintain fluid balance, aids in digestion, and balances body pH.
- **Phosphate (HPO₄²⁻):** Important for bone and teeth health, energy production, and cellular processes.

Why They are Important?



Nerve Function:

Electrolytes help transmit nerve signals, enabling communication between different parts of the nervous system.



Muscle Contraction

Electrolytes are essential for muscle contraction and relaxation, including the heartbeat.

Fluid Balance:

Electrolytes regulate the movement of water in and out of cells, maintaining proper hydration and blood pressure.



Energy Production:

Electrolytes are involved in various cellular processes, including energy production and metabolism.

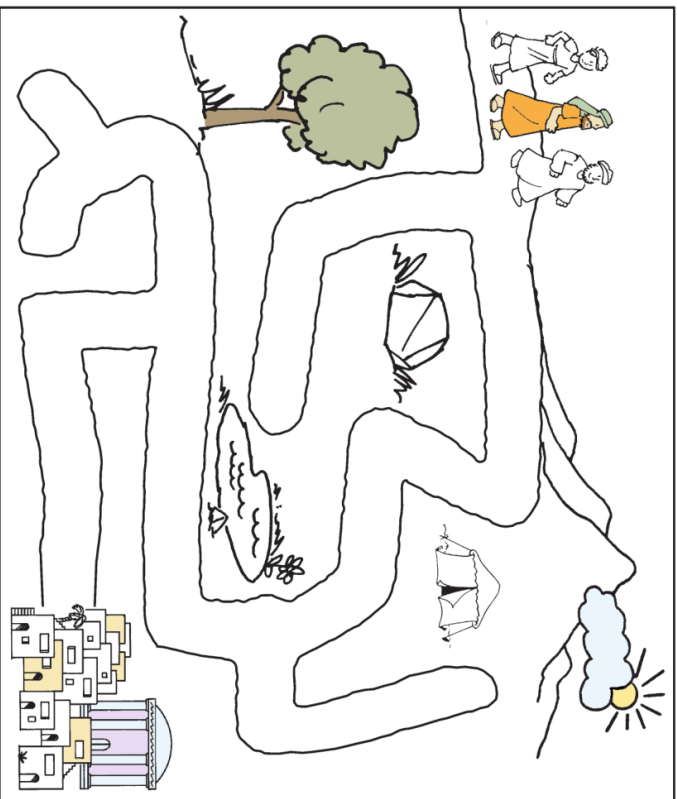

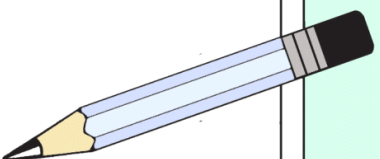

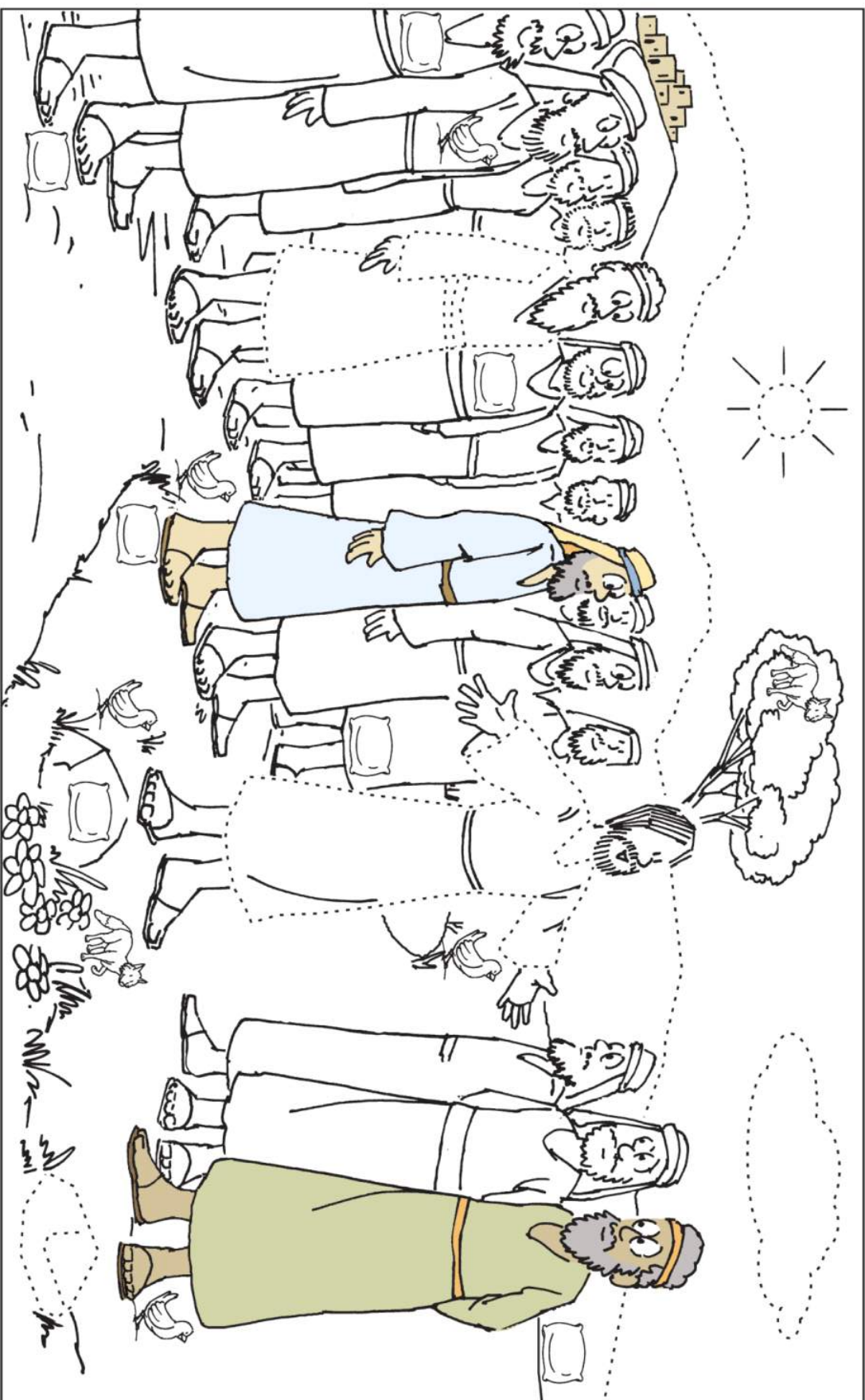
