Seeking Finance Council Members



The parish finance council is a consultative body which assists the pastor to act justly and prudently in the administration of the

parish's temporal goods.

The finance council has three main areas of responsibility: 1) Administration and Finance, 2) Facility Management, and 3) Stewardship and Development.

The ways the council fulfills its shared responsibility are: the spiritual enrichment and growth of the members; formation of financial policies, including the devising and regular monitoring of the parish and school budgets; formation of policies for the proper formation of the buildings and grounds of parish and school; long-range financial planning; and attention to civil law pertaining to the administration of temporal goods of the parish.

Scheduled meetings are held four times a year and ad hoc meetings are scheduled, as needed.

The council responsibilities require persons who are skilled in accounting and finance, property and personnel management and business law. The pastor appoints the members. To be considered, the candidate must be a practicing catholic in good standing who participates in the ongoing life of the parish and who is truly expert in financial affairs or business law with outstanding integrity.

Luke 12: 13- 21

- Listen/ Read (*Lectio*): Ponder God's word and listen for what touches your heart.
- Meditate (*Meditatio*): Attend to what you notice. Allow God's word to resonate in you.
- Speak/Share (*Oratio*): Prayerfully share with Jesus or with the group your thoughts and feelings.
- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Come and See



Be rich in what matters to God

And what matters to God? Typically, not the things we tend to focus on in life. Our Gospel

opens with two siblings disagreeing over a family inheritance. Jesus declines the offer to intervene and chooses instead to use the situation to address the broader, underlying issue: our priorities.

In his book *Confessions*, St. Augustine wrote, "Our weight is our love." Our weight is what matters most to us. It is our affections, desires, and what we prioritize. It is a powerful force that pulls us towards what we love, shaping our actions and defining who we are as persons. In essence, we *are* what we *love*. So if things in this world define our whole identity, what happens to us on the day when we leave them all behind?

This is the question raised by the book of Ecclesiastes. What is the point of devoting our lives to accumulating power, wealth, and possessions when we leave it all behind when we die? We attain the things we desire, hoping to satisfy our longing for happiness, but we continue to hunger for more. St. Augustine reminds us that we can only find that deep sense of joy and satisfaction with God. By focusing our lives on God, a gravitational pull develops that draws us towards God, and we become more like God. We *become* Who we *love*.

We become disciples rich in love, mercy, and forgiveness. We become beacons of hope for those in need. We become servants who share our time and resources with others. We become heralds of the Good News. We become a faith community, humbly walking with Jesus as we continue His ministry. And our lives will be rich in what matters to God.

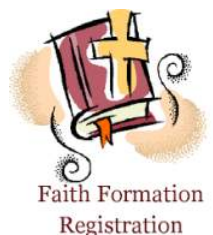
Coffee & Donuts Ministry Meeting

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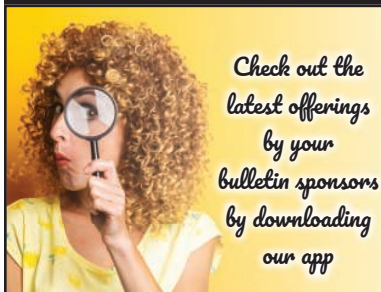
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
