Seeking Finance Council Members



The parish finance council is a consultative body which assists the pastor to act justly and prudently in the administration of the

parish's temporal goods.

The finance council has three main areas of responsibility: 1) Administration and Finance, 2) Facility Management, and 3) Stewardship and Development.

The ways the council fulfills its shared responsibility are: the spiritual enrichment and growth of the members; formation of financial policies, including the devising and regular monitoring of the parish and school budgets; formation of policies for the proper formation of the buildings and grounds of parish and school; long-range financial planning; and attention to civil law pertaining to the administration of temporal goods of the parish.

Scheduled meetings are held four times a year and ad hoc meetings are scheduled, as needed.

The council responsibilities require persons who are skilled in accounting and finance, property and personnel management and business law. The pastor appoints the members. To be considered, the candidate must be a practicing catholic in good standing who participates in the ongoing life of the parish and who is truly expert in financial affairs or business law with outstanding integrity.

- Rest in God's presence (*Contemplatio*): Notice God's presence and be still, surrounded by God's love.
- Choose to act (*Actio*): Trusting in God's nearness, commit to action rooted in love.

Come and See



"Much will be required of the person entrusted with much, and still more will be demanded of the person entrusted with more."

In our Gospel today, Jesus told his disciples this after also telling them, "You also must be prepared, for at an hour you do not expect, the Son of Man will come." I don't know about you, but when I read these words and warnings, I become a little alarmed. Am I prepared, or will I be caught off guard and unprepared when my time comes to face Jesus? Am I using the gifts with which I have been entrusted? Will God be disappointed in how I squandered the blessings I've received in this life? Am I following God's will, or my own?

It is easy to slip into feelings of fear and uncertainty pondering these readings. However, we can and should take comfort in the faithfulness of our God. It is evident throughout all of history, and definitely evident in reading the Old and New Testaments, that our God is a faithful God, even when we slip and fall and mess up (time and again!). Our second reading reminds us that, "Faith is the realization of what is hoped for and evidence of things not yet seen," and, "God is not ashamed to be their God, for He has prepared a city for them." We therefore need not live in fear and hypervigilance, but rather we should have faith and courage. God knows our weaknesses and is full of mercy, compassion and love for us. We can develop our relationship with God through prayer and by putting our hope in the Lord every day. In a practical way, let's start our day thanking God for all of our blessings, and asking God for guidance to be more aware of the Lord's will for our lives, of the blessings we have, and for guidance to use them all for God's greater glory.

So as we go into this new week, let us remember the words of Psalm 33 that remind us that we are blessed and should have hope because we have been chosen to be God's own. Let our daily prayer this week be, "May your kindness, O Lord, be upon us who have put our hope in you."

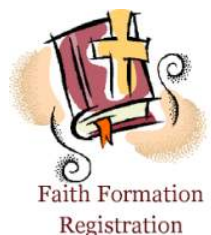
Coffee & Donuts Ministry Meeting
